

1. Intergovernmental Agreement – Currently all projects where Clayton County will serve as the contractor for the City require us to enter in to an agreement with the County. An intergovernmental agreement with Clayton County is being prepared that can be used for all construction projects of \$25,000.00 and less. This standing agreement will allow us to move quicker on small projects such as a road repair and improvements, sidewalk installation, signal improvements, etc. Of course all projects will adhere to the purchasing guidelines. The City Manager is leading this project.
2. LMIG (formerly LARP) – The GDOT has prepared a resurfacing contract for Carla Dr. and Merchants Way in the award amount of \$65,496.18. Public Works completed a project estimate for milling, patching, and resurfacing to establish the City portion of the project. The total project cost is estimated at \$94,600 or \$29,600 higher than the grant award. Public Works and Grants Administration will work this project.
3. City of Atlanta Department of Aviation - Southern Crescent Development Committee consisting of two elected officials or one elected official and the City Manager. The formation committee meeting 9-23-2011 at 8:00 a.m. It was decided that Councilwoman Jeanell Bridges, Jeff Eady, and Michael McLaughlin would attend.
4. Service Delivery Strategy – A letter will be sent to the Clayton County Legislative Delegation to inform them of the status of the negotiations between the Cities and the County. It is highly possible an alternative dispute resolution will be required (arbitration).
 - a. The C.C. Legislative Delegation will be invited to the September meeting of the C.C.M.A.
5. Open House Gateway Village – Economic Development office, Westwood Way, August 30-31, 2011 to view the concept Master Plan, Renderings, and possible name options. The goal of this meeting is to collect any feedback from the Board and Commissioners, City of Morrow Mayor & Council, team members and stakeholders.


