

**CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA
MINUTES OF SPECIAL CALLED MEETING
June 24, 2010 – 3:00 pm**

Mayor Jim Millirons called the special called meeting of the Morrow City Council to order at 3:10 pm. The meeting took place in the Council Chambers of the Morrow Municipal Complex, 1500 Morrow Road, Morrow, GA, 30260.

City Clerk Evyonne Browning called the roll and those present were Mayor Jim Millirons, Councilman Virlyn Slaton, Councilman C.R. Huie and Councilman Mason Barfield. Councilman John Lampl was absent, but there was a quorum present.

Mayor Jim Millirons asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silent reflection.

APPROVAL OF MEETING AGENDA

City Clerk Evyonne Browning stated there were no changes to the Meeting Agenda.

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a motion and vote to approve the Meeting Agenda.

MOTION AND VOTE: Councilmember Mason Barfield moved to approve the Meeting Agenda. Councilmember Bob Huie seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by those present.

CONSENT AGENDA: None

OLD BUSINESS:

City Clerk Evyonne Browning read the following Old Business item:

1. Agenda Item 10-06-137, Approval of an Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Morrow, Georgia, as it pertains to the recommendation, approval, and adoption of an Amended Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2010, beginning 1 July 2009 and ending 30 June 2010; to allocate Revenues and Expenditures for that period for the operation and enhancement of the various services delivered by the City to its citizens; for the health and well-being of the residents and businesses of the City of Morrow; and for other purposes.

City Manager Jeff Eady presented the item.

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a motion and second.

MOTION AND SECOND: Councilmember Mason Barfield moved to approve Agenda Item 10-06-137. Councilmember Bob Huie seconded the motion.

Mayor Jim Millirons called for any discussion. There was none.

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a vote.

VOTE: The motion passed unanimously by those present.

City Clerk Evyonne Browning read the next Old Business item:

2. Agenda Item 10-06-138, Approval of an Ordinance entitled an Ordinance to amend the Code of Ordinances of the City of Morrow, Georgia, as it pertains to the recommendation, approval, and adoption of an Annual Budget for the Fiscal Year 2011, beginning 1 July 2010 and ending 30 June 2011; to allocate Revenues and Expenditures for that period for the operation and enhancement of the various services delivered by the City to its citizens; for the health and well-being of the residents and businesses of the City of Morrow; and for other purposes.

City Manager Jeff Eady presented the item.

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a motion and second.

MOTION AND SECOND: **Councilman Bob Huie** stated that on June 8th the Council asked the City Manager to make certain recommended changes to the budget. Those recommendations have been met and he moved to approve Agenda Item 10-06-138. Mason Barfield seconded the motion.

Mayor Jim Millirons called for any discussion. There was none.

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a vote.

VOTE: The motion passed unanimously by those present.

COMMENTS:

Mayor Jim Millirons made the call to citizens for comments.

Danny Rudd a citizen of Morrow stated that several streets within the city limits had been renamed, such as Millirons and Huie and he made a recommendation that the new small street that is behind the Krystal be renamed "Short Street" because it is so short.

Mayor Jim Millirons asked Mr. Rudd where Millirons Street is located and it was determined that it was not in the City. He then said that they would take his recommendation into consideration.

Mayor Jim Millirons asked if the City Manager had any comments. He did not.

Mayor Jim Millirons asked if the Council had any comments.

Councilman Bob Huie replied (humorously) to Mr. Rudd's comment about Huie Street and he said that street was renamed long before he was ever born.

EXECUTIVE SESSION (To Discuss a Personnel Matter)

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a motion and vote to adjourn into Executive Session to discuss personnel.

MOTION AND VOTE: Councilmember Bob Huie moved to adjourn into Executive Session to discuss Personnel. Councilmember Mason Barfield seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by those present and the meeting adjourned into Executive Session at 3:24 pm.

ADJOURN EXECUTIVE SESSION AND RECONVENE REGULAR MEETING:

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a motion and vote to adjourn the Executive Session and reconvene the regular meeting.

MOTION AND VOTE: Councilmember Mason Barfield moved to adjourn the Executive Session and reconvene the Special Called Meeting. Councilmember Bob Huie seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by those present and the Special Called Meeting was reconvened at 4:27 pm.

ADJOURNMENT:

Mayor Jim Millirons called for a motion and vote to adjourn the meeting.

MOTION AND VOTE: Councilmember Mason Barfield moved to adjourn the Special Called Meeting. Councilmember Bob Huie seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously by those present and the Special Called Meeting was adjourned at 4:28pm.
