

**CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
October 23, 2012 – 7:30 pm**

Mayor Burke called the regular meeting of the Morrow City Council to order at 7:30 pm. The meeting took place in the Council Chambers of the Morrow Municipal Complex, 1500 Morrow Road, Morrow, GA, 30260.


Mayor Pro Tem Bridges congratulated Sylvia and Dat and also reminded everyone about the Walk for Domestic Violence on October 27th.
