

CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING
May 14, 2013 – 7:30 pm

Mayor Burke called the regular meeting of the Morrow City Council to order at 7:30 pm. The meeting took place in the Council Chambers of the Morrow Municipal Complex, 1500 Morrow Road, Morrow, GA, 30260.

City Clerk Evyonne Browning called the roll and those present were Mayor JB Burke, Councilwoman Jeanell Bridges, Councilman Virlyn Slaton, Councilman C.R. Huie, and Mayor Pro Tem Larry Ferguson. She stated there was a quorum present.

Mayor Burke asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silent reflection.

Mayor Burke welcomed Boy Scout Troop 4234 to the meeting.

Councilwoman Jeanell Bridges thanked the Boy Scouts for being here tonight.

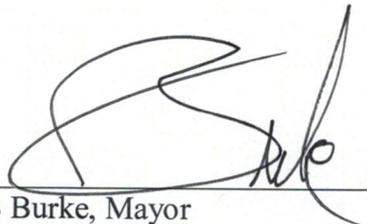
Mayor Burke again thanked the Boy Scouts from Troop 4234 for being here.

ADJOURNMENT:

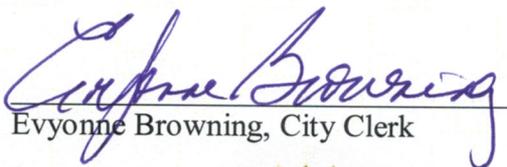
Mayor Burke called for a motion to adjourn the meeting.
